Dear Hiring Manager,

Barona's strategic scaling of its Digital Language Academy through the Arffman subsidiary to solve severe Nordic healthcare labor shortages provides the ideal relocation pathway for an EU-citizen clinician ready to deploy. My recent two years of adaptable multi-site agency deployment, anchored by five years of clinical exposure to ECMO/ECLS in dedicated cardiac and ARDS ICUs, perfectly align with your mission to seamlessly integrate international talent into Scandinavia's critical care workforce. As an EU citizen, I am fully committed to undertaking intensive Nordic language training to reach B2 proficiency, leveraging EU Directive 2005/36/EC for clinical integration into Nordic healthcare facilities following language acquisition.

Rapid clinical integration across diverse protocols is the exact capability required for Barona's cross-border staffing model. Agency deployment with KCS Medical and Komorebi Staffing across multiple Berlin ICUs significantly expanded my clinical scope beyond a single institutional environment. Gaining experience with TAVI and Mitraclip post-procedural care, acute dialysis, and plasmapheresis ensured safe post-operative management through multidisciplinary haemodynamic assessment. This proven adaptability across varying electronic documentation systems and team structures guarantees a seamless transition into Nordic hospital wards following language acquisition.

High-acuity cardiac and respiratory failure expertise provides the clinical foundation necessary to function independently in unfamiliar Nordic specialist centres. Time spent at dedicated cardiac and ARDS ICUs across LMU Klinikum Grosshadern and Deutsches Herzzentrum der Charite established deep competence in mechanical ventilation, IABP, and Impella management. Clinical exposure to ECMO/ECLS in both cardiac and respiratory failure settings, including patient monitoring and participation in weaning discussions, provided critical support in refractory cases. Managing the full post-operative trajectory for heart and lung transplant patients enabled clinical teams to stabilise complex haemodynamic rejection scenarios effectively.

A conversation regarding the Digital Language Academy would allow me to detail a realistic timeline for my Nordic relocation and language acquisition. I would welcome the opportunity to discuss how my cardiac ICU background and agency adaptability could support Barona's strategic priority of scaling global talent integration across Scandinavia.
