Cardiac and ARDS ICU care across LMU Klinikum Grosshadern and Deutsches Herzzentrum der Charite (DHZC) provides the clinical depth required for specialist placements in Scandinavia. Caring for post-operative heart and lung transplant patients at Germany's highest-volume cardiac centre involved rigorous haemodynamic stabilisation and immunosuppression monitoring, ensuring safe post-operative trajectories for complex cases. Clinical exposure to ECMO/ECLS, IABP, and Impella in both respiratory failure and cardiogenic shock settings enabled multidisciplinary teams to sustain bridge-to-transplant patients through critical vulnerability periods.
